This is obviously a very expensive project so please do buy a seat if you can.

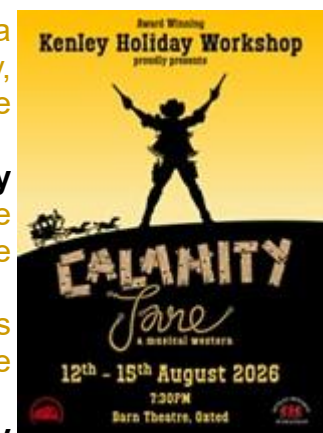
